Events, vigils and gatherings take place all across the world to mark the day, and this year, the Centre for HIV & Sexual Health, in partnership with TransBareAll and Engage With - Training & Consultancy, is co-ordinating an event to take place in Sheffield.

The event is open to anyone from transgender communities and their partners, families, friends. Service providers and anyone looking to support the community are also welcome.

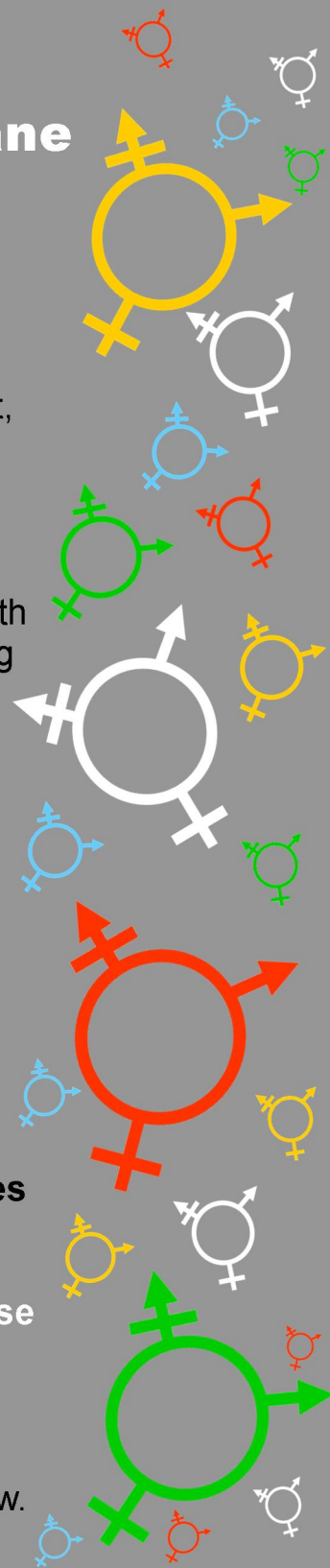
The event will include:
