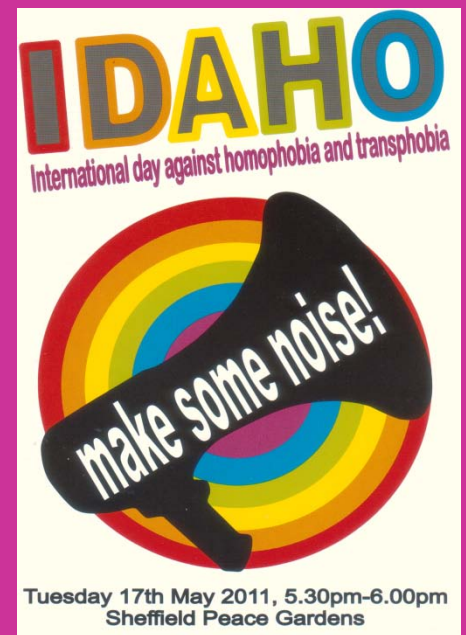

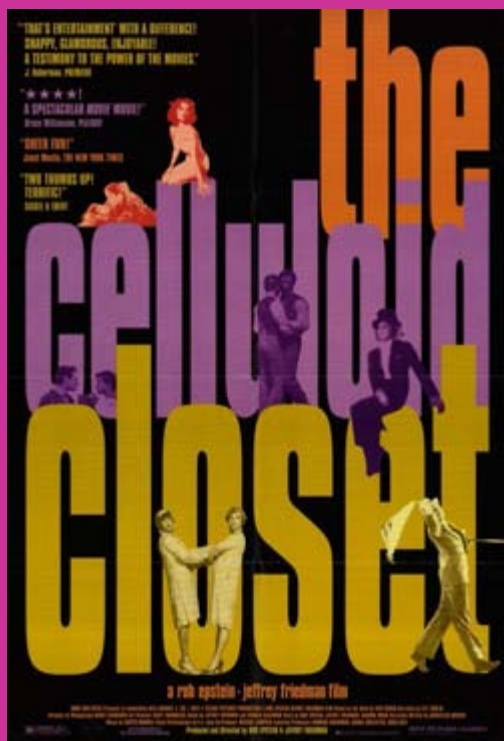

Network Launch 17th May 2010

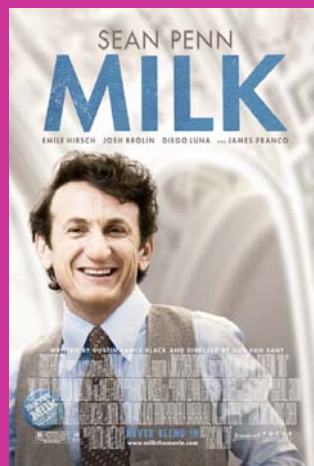
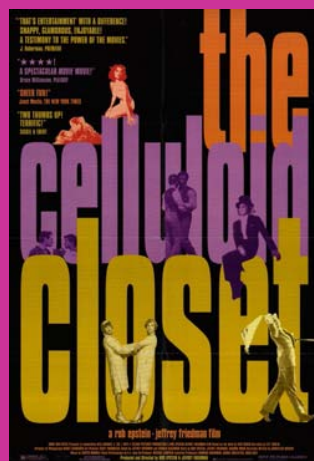
