- Birth/adoption of a child
- Return from maternity/adoption leave
- Start of marriage/civil partnership
- End of marriage/civil partnership/long term relationship
- Material change in own/partner/dependant's circumstances
- Commencement of a period of long term absence or secondment
- Return from a period of long term absence or secondment
- Significant change in working hours, job or contractual terms of employment
- Joining/leaving the pension scheme

- Reaching 2 years' pensionable service.

I will make employee contributions at the appropriate level into the pension scheme. For members of the Universities Superannuation Scheme this is 8.0% of pensionable salary plus any 'match' or additional voluntary contributions; for members of the University of Sheffield Pension Scheme this is between 2% and 10% of pensionable salary, depending upon the level of contributions you have chosen.

I understand that through opting out of Salary Sacrifice for pensions at this time, I will not be able to participate in Salary Sacrifice for pensions until the next Salary Sacrifice for pensions renewal date (1 April next) or until I experience a Lifestyle Event (see above) if earlier.
